



ALCOHOL & SUBSTANCE ABUSE POLICY (CODE OF CONDUCT)

The 2020 Grad Bash Cruise is an exciting event uniting graduating seniors to take a celebratory trip to make memories for a lifetime. Our Grad Bash event takes place each Spring for graduating seniors!

As a participant of the 2020 Grad Bash Cruise, you will be required to adhere to the following **Code of Conduct**. Please read it and sign at the bottom of the page.

1. I know that it is illegal for me to purchase tobacco products under the age of 21. I will not use tobacco. I understand that no smoking is allowed for anyone under the age of 21 on this trip.
2. There will be no possession or use of any narcotics, marijuana, other illegal drugs or prescription drugs not specifically prescribed for the user. I will not "hang out" with anyone underage while they are using alcohol or drugs.
3. I know that it is illegal for me to drink alcoholic beverages before I am 21 years old. I will not possess any alcoholic beverages throughout the duration of this trip.
4. I know that weapons are not allowed, including, but not limited to knives, firearms, tasers, batons, and etc. I will not engage in any type of illegal behavior that includes tobacco, illegal drugs, alcohol, and/or weapons.
5. I understand that any participant caught in possession of or using alcohol or illegal drugs, may be detained and sent home at the parent's expense from the next scheduled port of call.
6. I am aware that while on this trip, I am under the care and supervision of law-abiding adults. I understand that I am subject to the laws of the ship destination and ports. Customary U.S. laws and protections will not be guaranteed if student is detained for illegal activities.
7. Participants are expected to dress respectfully and maintain proper decorum and attitude during the entire trip. Disruptive behavior (including, among other things, inappropriate sexual innuendo) will not be tolerated in any way, shape or form. Your parents will be responsible to pay for any damage you may cause.
8. Each participant understands there will be scheduled room checks several times each date of the trip. Participants agree to adhere to the set guidelines for rooming policies and curfew restrictions. Participants are also required to report to required events specified by the schedule.
9. Each participant is expected to conduct him/herself appropriately during the trip, including the observance of the Discovery HS student handbook, in accordance with the standards of the trip organizers. Not adhering to set guidelines could result in disciplinary actions, including, but not limited to suspension, expulsion, and/or restricting graduation privileges.
10. The Discovery HS PTSA trip organizers & chaperones reserve the right to enforce other rules relating to the integrity of the trip and/or the health, safety or welfare of its participants.

I have read these rules and understand them fully. I certify that I will adhere to this code and will conduct myself in a manner reflecting credit upon my peers, my community and myself.

I understand that any violation of this Code of Conduct may result in my being sent home at my parents' expense. The Discovery HS PTSA trip organizers & the chaperones have the discretion to send a participant home.
